Description: This picture, probably taken in the early 1900's, shows the corner of Broadway and Washington Avenue (now the site of a restaurant and other stores) once was a cattle grazing field. In the background is Werkheiser's Hotel (later Lucy Smith's Drygoods Store, and also called "Hillsdale House"). In the foreground is Mr. Werkheiser and his dog. Mr. Arthur Smith purchased the hotel building in 1921; together, he and his wife (and she alone after his death) operated the drygoods emporium until 1961.
