Description: Hillsdale's second train station, known as "Hillsdale Manor House," was located off Broadway and Park Avenue east of the Pascack Brook. The two-story structure, complete with a rounded fieldstone entrance and black turret, was the "uptown" station for those residents living between the downtown Hillsdale and Woodcliff Lake railroad stations. The Manor section of Hillsdale was once a popular vacation resort; in addition to the station, the area had its own store and hotels. For two years, the building served as the town hall, and later became the Lake View Inn, and has since been demolished.
